Meeting called to order: 5:00 p.m.

I. Welcome: Done by Jaime Washington

II. Minutes: Approval of November minutes were motioned by Leanne McKelvey. Minutes were approved.

III. Budget: Request from the Biology PLC on 2/17/15 for Spring Semester day of planning. Dr. Reynolds requested the following: To ensure supervision for the spring semester with Mr. Haws for after-hours along with payment for Mr. Burgess for extended time. The SAC Committee voted and approved the budgeted line items. Motioned by LeAnne McKelvey and second by Robert McIntosh. The projected cost for academic tutoring is to change to \$5,667.09 with a balance of 3,500. Plato Lab extended hours projected cost should be changed from \$3,000.00 to \$2,300.00 with a projected balance of \$1,631.64. Finally the remaining balance of \$3,032.91 will go to security to cover for the remainder of the school year. The teacher grant allocation will now go towards the Biology PLC for 2/17/15 and this will dissolve the balance left in this line item.

IV. Athletic Report: Mr. Luppert discussed spring sports have held tryouts. Competitive cheer squad is back and competing in State Girls and Boys. Boys and Girls Soccer were in the district semifinals along with Girls and Boys basketball. Wrestling team is currently ranked #2 in the State. Mr. Luppert is finalizing the proposal to host the cross country state meet for the next 2 years. Athletic signing day will be on 2/4/15.

V. A+ Bonus Vote: Mr. York discussed the ballot and the results that were emailed from the faculty and staff members. Questions were addressed as it related to the personnel whom would receive the bonus and the allocation amounts. Ms. Gomez expressed that there were some concerns among the faculty. Dr. Reynolds reported that she placed the equal share proposal on the ballot while the tiered proposal was approved by the committee. The SAC Committee voted and approved the A+ vote of equal share for all faculty and staff. Mr. McIntosh motioned and it was seconded by Carol Unterreiner. Motion carried.

VI. Principal's Report:

IB Program: School Board approved Winter Springs High School for an IB program. Program will be implemented in Fall 2016.

Testing update: Final Discovery Education for progress monitoring will take place next week. FSA writing will take place in March.

Climate Survey: Dr. Reynolds advised everyone that now is the time to take the climate survey. It is open and available.

Accreditation Visit: Our accreditation visit will take place on 2/9/15 and 2/10/15.

Registration: Handout was presented from Ms. Monte-Carlo. Registration will begin with 9th graders on 2/18/15. The 10th and 11th graders will follow within that week.

Curriculum Night: Will be held on 2/5/15 with an FSA presentation starting at 5:30 p.m.

VII. New Business:

Mr. York brought to the board that we will need to update our By-Laws and to incorporate guidelines for public speakers/comments within our by-laws for next month meeting.

Questions/Concerns: Jennifer Devine spoke about tiered proposals for A+ bonus money and the steps taken by the A+ Committee as it related to the plans submitted. She reported that the committee had only one option because support staff did not bring a tiered proposal to the committee. Norm Erickson indicated that the committee did not vote on the final ballot and the final vote did not get the approval of the A+ Committee.
