Meeting called to order: 5:00 p.m.

I. Welcome: Mrs. Demme-San Filippo asked all attendees to introduce themselves.

II. Minutes: Approval of January minutes, as were amended, motioned by Nora L'Heureux, Carol Unterreiner seconded it.

III. Budget: Dr. Reynolds directed our attention to the fact that after school security and academic tutoring have both received their allotments from the SAC fund leaving a balance of \$8,763.31. Two teacher grant proposals were submitted for discussion. First was the request by Mrs. Carmen Beasley for 4 iPads to be purchased for her students who are unable to view her class videos from home. Dr. Reynolds hopes to reimburse the SAC committee with forthcoming AP money. It was decided by vote that we would allow the purchase of one laptop computer for \$714.00 as a test to see if it was used effectively as intended or if perhaps using the media/testing center would be of equal use. Secondly the Biology department requested 3 planning days: 9/21/15, 1/25/16 & 2/23/16. Leanne McKelvey motioned for the 2 days of paid leave to start with and it was seconded by Lori Bowman.

IV. Principal's Report: Instructional, non-instructional, parents and students were confirmed as SAC participants. RoseMarie Shor was voted in as recording secretary. Discussion ensued on the best way to encourage members of minority groups and it was decided that an email note would be sent out by the principal asking for interested members to create a more diverse committee.

A By-Laws committee consisting of Bobbie Demme-San Filippo, Lori Bowman and Carol Unterreiner will continue to work on the WSHS SAC updates.

Robert's Rules of Order were reviewed by Bobbie Demme-San Filippo.

V. Questions/ Concerns: A question was raised about security on campus for students' valuables. Dr. Reynolds talked about some of the security measures that were not followed during a recent incident and how teachers have been reminded of proper procedures. In addition the PE dept. was given several strong hold boxes (created by the shop students at WSHS) to use for students' belongings during class. Another member expressed frustration that grades are not posted promptly by some teachers on Skyward.
